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Opportunity Cost

What

Opportunity cost is the value of what you give up by choosing one task over another.

How

Regularly review your backlog and assess the impact of deferred tasks. Implement a bi-weekly review meeting where you evaluate what has been postponed and why.

When

Schedule these reviews at the end of each sprint or biweekly to ensure continuous alignment with your overall goals.



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Team Morale & Burnout

What

High-priority tasks often come with high stress and tight deadlines, leading to team burnout if not managed well.

How

Integrate less critical but engaging tasks into your sprints. Use tools like pulse surveys to gauge team morale and adjust workloads accordingly.

When

Conduct pulse surveys monthly and adjust sprint plans based on the feedback to ensure a balanced workload.



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Innovation Stifling

What

Focusing too rigidly on prioritized tasks can stifle innovation by not allowing time for creative thinking and experimentation.

How

Allocate specific times for low-priority tasks that encourage experimentation. Create a culture that values and rewards innovative ideas.

When

Set aside a few hours each week or dedicate the last Friday of the month as an innovation day where the team can explore new ideas.
